Invibio Ltd is committed to ensuring full REACH<sup>(1)</sup> compliance for all our current and future products whilst ensuring no disruption in the marketing and supply of those products.

- Victrex has registered all required substances manufactured in or imported into the EU by Victrex. In addition, Victrex is working closely with suppliers to ensure key substances, which support the supply chain and are manufactured in or imported into the EU, are registered.
- Victrex polymer grades are exempt from the REACH registration requirements. However, the monomers used in the polymer manufacture have been registered in accordance with the requirements of REACH<sup>(2)</sup>.
- Victrex do not intentionally add or use any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) >0.1%w/w <https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>, or any substances listed in Annex XVII "The Restricted List" <https://echa.europa.eu/substances-restricted-under-reach>, or any substances listed in Annex XIV "The Authorisation List" <https://echa.europa.eu/authorisation-list>, in its products. It is policy to monitor all new and existing suppliers to ensure we do not supply material containing these substances.

- The Candidate List is reviewed and added to on a regular basis. If at any point we are found to be incorporating a Substance of Very High Concern >0.1%w/w into any of our products we will reflect this in an update to the relevant Material Safety Data Sheet.
- Victrex products are not classified as dangerous<sup>(3)</sup>, PBT<sup>(4)</sup> or vPvB<sup>(5)</sup> and do not require Exposure Scenarios. Technical Data Sheets providing customer guidance on the safe use of Victrex products are readily available through our website [www.victrex.com](http://www.victrex.com).
- As a downstream user, Victrex continues to work with suppliers to ensure all raw materials will be supported and our manufacturing processes will not be affected.
